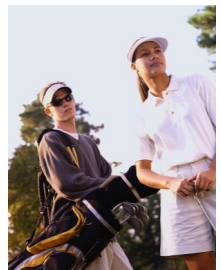
Wednesday Night Ladies Golf League

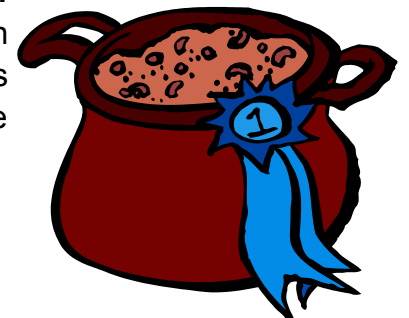
